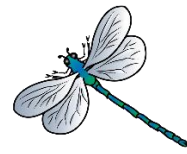

Next week our Year 6 students are sitting their SATS exams, the rest of the school and all staff would like to wish them Good Luck!



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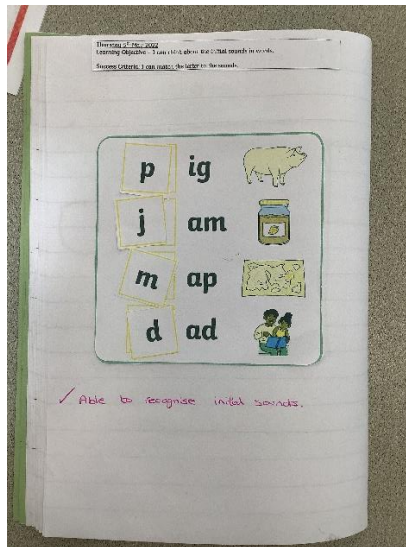
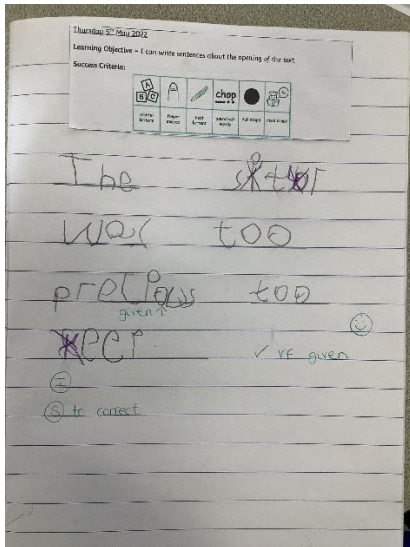
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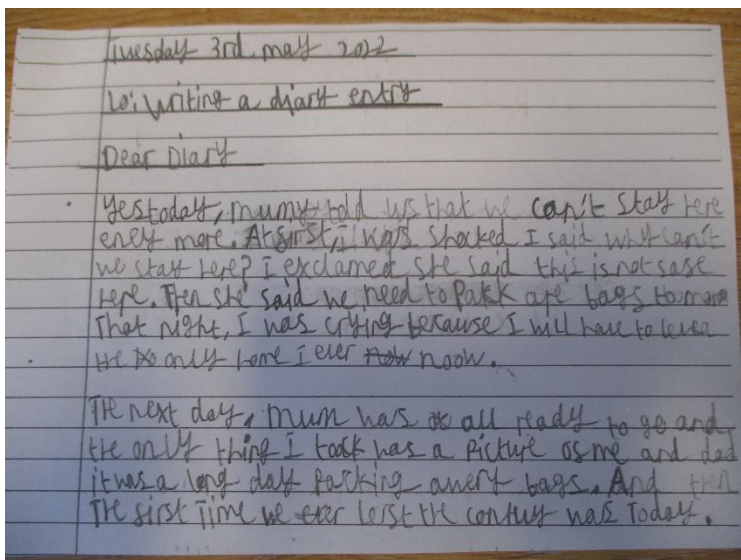
