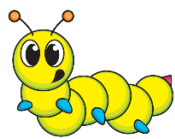

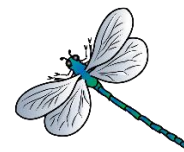
Butterfly Class

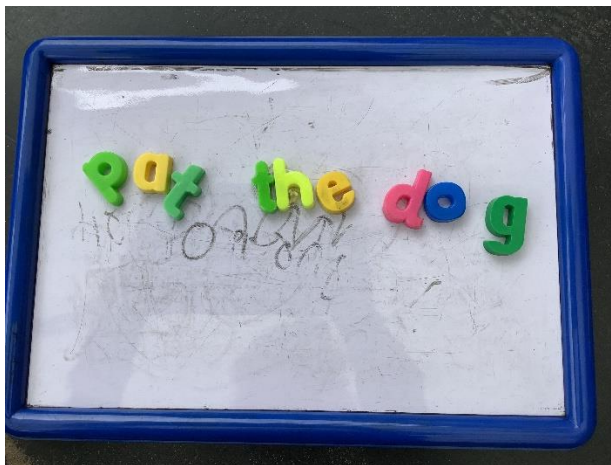

### Reading at Home

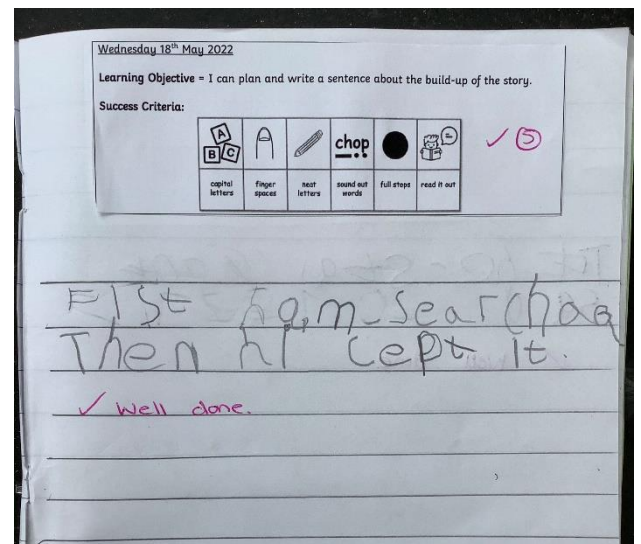

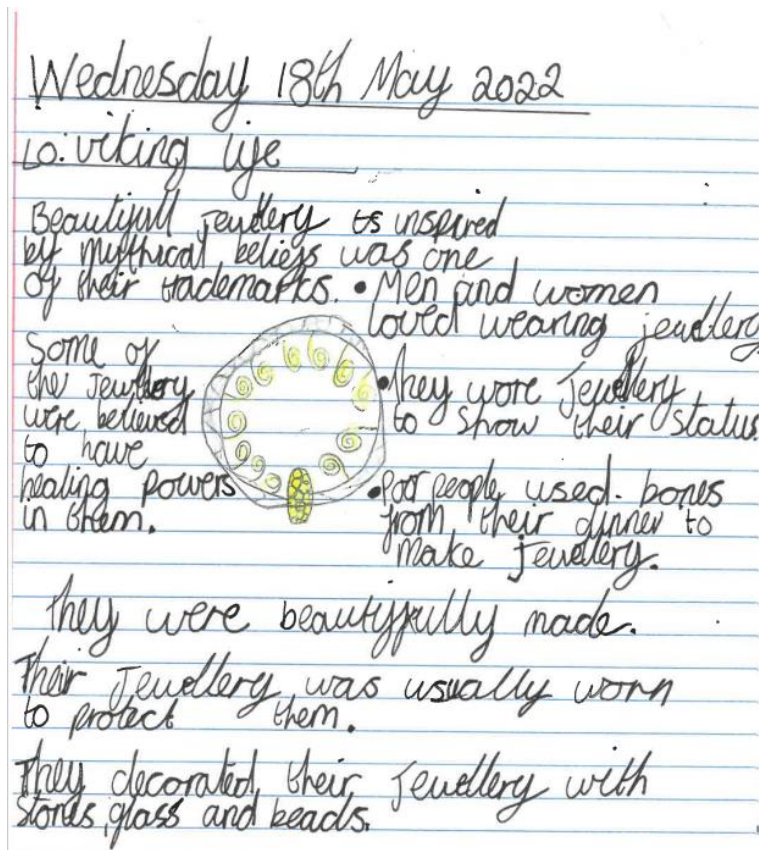

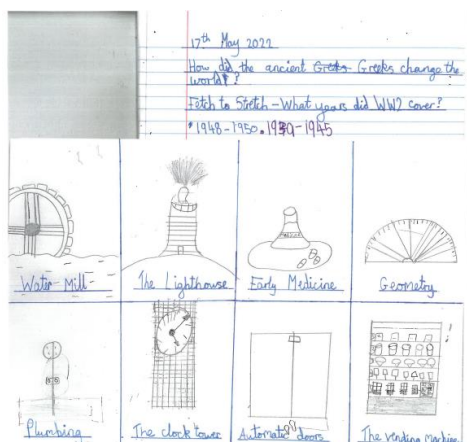
