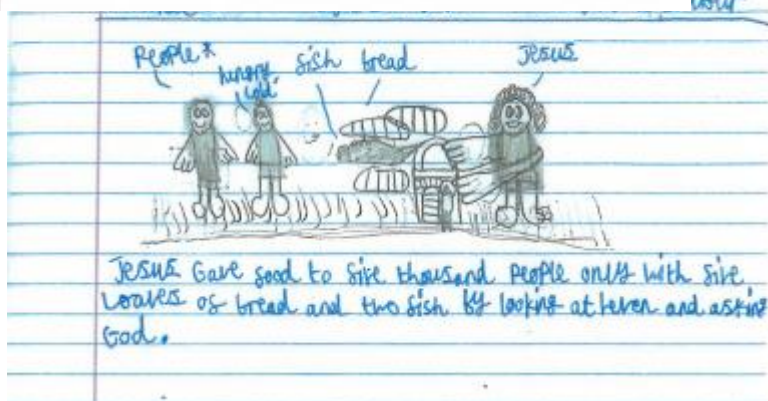

their sockets.





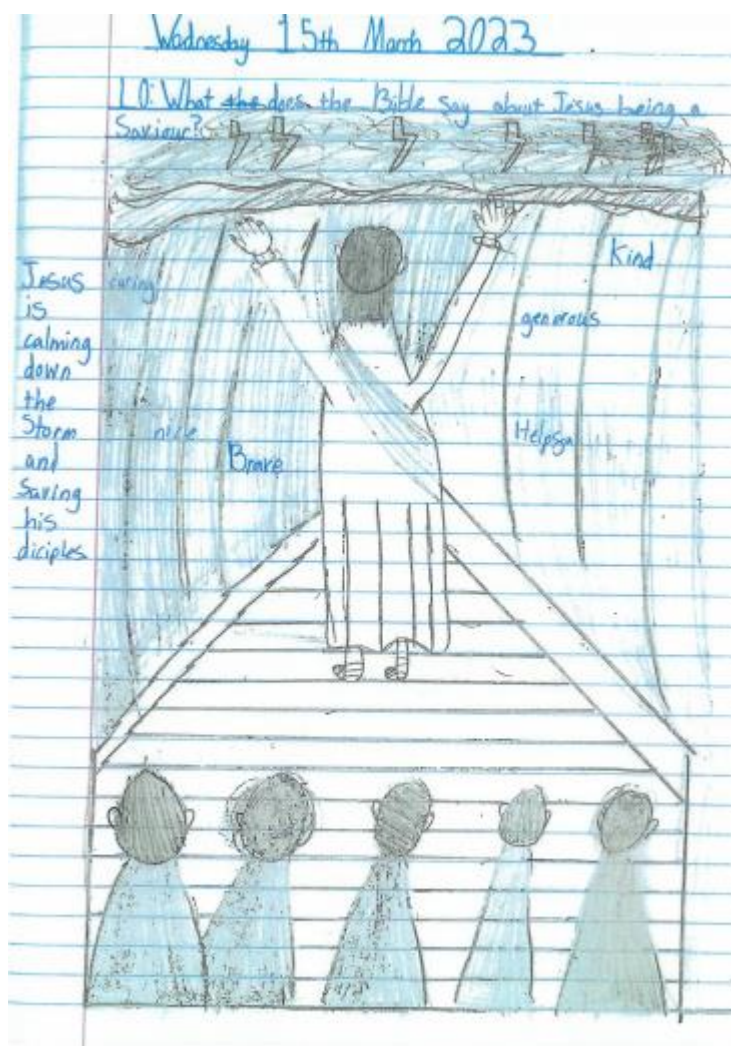
