Ladybird and Caterpillar class enjoyed going on an Autumn walk, looking for different leaves.



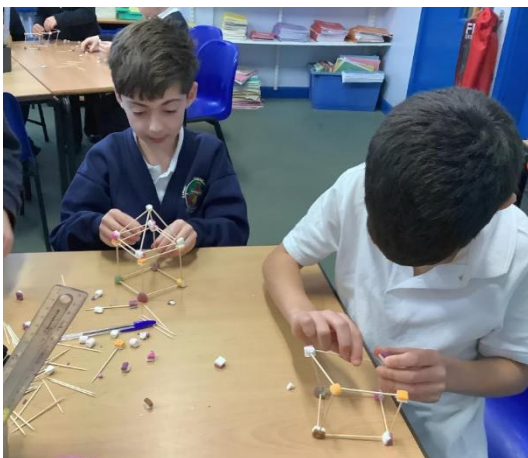
