All the children were brilliant in this year's Nativity plays. Thank you for coming to support them, we hope that you enjoyed it!





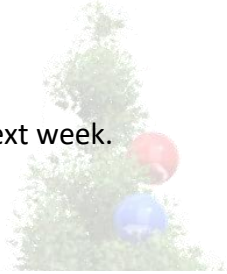

School Council will start selling numbers next week.



Dear Parents and Guardians,

The School Council would like to raise money for new play equipment for our school. To support this, the Friends of Parkers will be running a Bonus Ball Raffle on behalf of the School Council, under their small lotteries licence.

Each number costs £12 for six weeks (equivalent to £2 per week). The first draw will take place on 10th January, and the final draw will be on 14th February. If your chosen number matches the Bonus Ball drawn in the National Lottery that week, you will win a cash prize. The exact amount will depend on the number of entries received.

You will have the opportunity to sign up and pay via BACs, and full payment details will be provided when you register.
