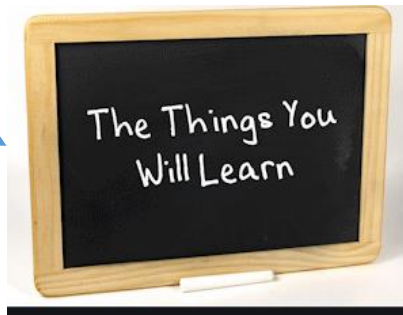

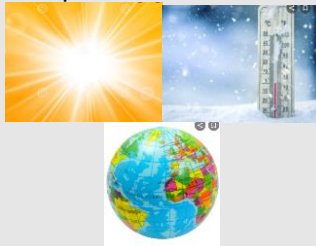

Choose one of these activities to complete over the next three weeks. Upload your work onto

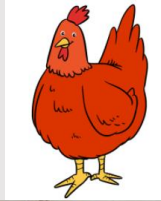


. Please give it the title **'Topic Homework'**.
